The following are the criteria for the event:

*You have a gallery or working studio located on Waiheke.

* Visitors will be able to see your creative process and materials as well as works for sale. (You have a dedicated area for this.)

* It would make a great visitor experience if you had some kind of refreshments or similar on offer for Open Studios ticket holders. (ie: the Gallery shop will be offering 10% discount for ticket holders, you could offer snacks/ refreshments, specials or a creative enjoyable environment as you have in the past).

*Your studio is accessible to visitors. If you have no parking nearby or a very long drive this may be tricky.

*You are willing to be open 10am-4pm for the entire Kings Birthday weekend (Saturday, Sunday, Monday).

If you have extra space, you can invite other artists to share your space. The \$55 fee will cover a printed guide as well as signage and marketing. The cost is per studio not per artist so if you have multiple artists the fee is still just \$55.

The Big Red dots will be back in action to mark your studios. If you have not participated in this event before you will see these soon.

Waiheke Open Studios 2025 will be a ticketed event promoted through the Gallery and across Waiheke. A printed brochure will function as the ticket for visitors to explore studios.

We are planning an afternoon soiree at the Gallery with a themed silent auction- more information to follow.
