# SMALL SCULPTURE PRIZE

Presented by Perpetual Guardian in association with Te Motu Vineyard and the Waiheke Community Art Gallery.

THE SMALL SCULPTURE PRIZE IS A NATIONAL AWARD FOR AN ORIGINAL FREE-STANDING OR WALL SCULPTURE UP TO 800MM IN ANY DIMENSION.

Presented by Perpetual Guardian in association with Te Motu Vineyard and Waiheke Community Art Gallery, the Small Sculpture Prize will take place between 3 June – 3 July 2022. The Prize is \$3000, with a Merit Prize of \$1,500.

## HOW TO ENTER

From Monday 28 March 2022, you will find a link on our Home Page, [www.waihekeartgallery.org.nz](http://www.waihekeartgallery.org.nz) providing access to the entry page.

If this is your first visit to our website you will need to create an account—this is a record of your details. Once this is completed you will be taken to the Entry Form. Complete the on the on-line submission form (in a sequential manner) Jpeg images no larger than 2 MB, Artist Statement, CV, (Word or PDF) including special requirements for display, i.e., power. Concluding with the entry fee of \$45 (non-refundable) paid on-line.

We recommend that you prepare your Artists Statement, CV and all imagery to the required file format and size before completing the entry form. Follow the process through by using 'continue' at the bottom of the page as this will progress through to the payment.

## ENTRY CRITERIA

**Entries open on Monday 28 March and close Monday 18 April 2022.** Up to two works may be submitted and a maximum of two images of each work must accompany the submission. Work should not have been exhibited previously.

Each entry should also include an artist's statement (max 50 words) and an up to date CV. Images need to be either of a completed work or scans of drawings or designs of work yet to be made. Special requirements for installation, ie. power supply need also to be included.

Work should be well packed for transport and courier tickets or alternative arrangements made for works return at the conclusion of the exhibition.

## SELECTION & JUDGING

Your images go into an image gallery which can then be accessed by our selector.

From the submissions the selector and judge will decide on the finalists to be exhibited at the gallery.

Artists will be advised of selection or non-selection on **Monday 16 May 2022.**

From the finalists the judge will select the award winner.

The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
